1) Agenda - 12th Coordinating Board Meeting

The Ex. Comm discussed the proposed agenda for the 12th Stop TB Partnership Coordinating Board meeting to be held in Geneva, 18-19 April 2007.

The Ex. Comm. generally welcomed the draft agenda but made several additions and amendments.

- Add a brief update on the status of the evaluation
- The section on TB financing should also include a discussion on the roll out plan for the World Bank Study

- Ensure participants in the round table are fully briefed [Sec & ME]
- Discuss with the Chair of the TB-HIV WG the content of the TB-HIV session and clarify content. [ME]
- Invite WHO HIV Dept (Kevin DeCock) to be a respondent in session on TB-HIV [ME]
- Invite TDR to be respondent in session on TB Research Movement [ME]
- Invite the WHO ADG to give the closing remarks [ME]
- Circulate draft agenda to full Board for further comment [ME]

2) Election of the Vice Chair

The election of a new Vice Chair is required at the 12th Stop TB Partnership Coordinating Board meeting

The Ex. Comm agreed that there should be balance of representation between the Chair and Vice-Chair and therefore would encourage the election of a representative of the high burden countries to the position of Vice Chair.

- Agreed that all nominees were suitably qualified
- Decided that a vote should take place electronically before the meeting so that, in principle, the result can be confirmed in Geneva
- Contact Members nominated and assess their willingness to stand [ME].
- Arrange an electronic vote by all Board member prior to the Geneva Board. [ME]
