1. Situation of Chair of the Stop TB Partnership Coordinating Board

This was discussed at the previous Executive Committee teleconference (its 35th held on 13 March 2012). However no decision was reached before the teleconference line automatically disconnected all conference participants after the call overran.

In light of the Stop TB partnership by-laws and recent decisions taken by the Coordinating Board, members of the Executive Committee were uncertain whether Professor Atun could remain as Chair of the Stop TB Partnership given he is no longer the Global Fund representative.
